# **TOMATO COMMODITY SURVEY**

Conduct moth trapping surveys at 10 sites in 7 counties, one trap per site for each of the five arthropod pests species listed below:

- Silver Y Moth (Autographa gamma)
- Egyptian Cottonworm (Spodoptera littoralis)
- Old World Bollworm (Helicoverpa armigera)
- o Golden Twin Spot Moth (Chrysodeixis chalcites)
- Light Brown Apple Moth (Epiphyas postvittana)

Counties included: Addison, Chittenden, Franklin, Grand Isle, Orange, Orleans and Washington.

Scouts included: Scott Lewins, Beret Halverson, Sarah Kingsley-Richards and Ann Hazelrigg

Specific traps for each pest were set out and brought back to the UVM Plant Diagnostic Clinic to be examined on a 14 day schedule from June through September, 2020. Lures were changed at appropriate times as dictated by pest and trap. All survey activity followed the approved method and survey guidelines for pest surveillance in the CAPS Pest Datasheet (https://pest.ceris.purdue.edu/).

Results: None of the pests listed were found at any of the 10 sites in 7 counties on any date (greenhouse or field tomatoes).

# Survey dates (traps set and/or collected)
