## Proposed and Approved changes to Dean's List and Latin Honors policies.

The registrar, Associate Dean's, and Provost's office representative requested the SAC review and consider changes to [at that time] policies covering both Dean's List and Latin Honors awards. The status quo presented challenges to all units. There was not one established policy for Dean's list designations or Latin Honors. A variety of proposals were presented to the SAC the final decisions for changes are indicated below. For both proposals the SAC votes for approval were unanimous.

## Dean's List

Proposed criteria-change to policy: Status is awarded to full-time undergraduate students whose GPA is 3.7 or higher in the semester in question.

The motion was approved.

## <u>Latin Honors</u>

Proposed criteria-change in policy: top 25% of class in a college/school, divided into the following levels:

Top 5% of the class is awarded Summa cum laude

Next 10% of the class is awarded Magna cum laude

Next 10% of the class is awarded Cum laude

The motion was approved.

The resolution proposed by Jay Jacobs on behalf of the division of enrollment management was voted on, approved and sent on to the FS Ex Council.
